Re: Downtown CIP priorities FY 2021

Dear Councilman Ward,

I am writing on behalf of the Downtown Community Planning Council (DCPC) to inform you of our FY 2021 CIP priorities for Downtown.

We have a number of priorities which are already in the works and would like to ensure those are completed. They include East Village Green Park and the Children's Park modifications; the at grade crossing of Park Blvd at Harbor Drive; traffic signals at Pacific Hwy & Beech, Broadway & 15th and F St & 15th; continued progress on the Complete Streets Mobility Plan just to name a few. Generally we'd like to see all the previously approved projects to get fully funded, in process and completed.

For new FY2021, please see below DCPC priorities:

1. Progress on St Joseph's Park (Ash – Beech, 3rd - 4th)
2. A traffic light or some form of pedestrian improvement at Kettner Blvd & A St and
3. Crosswalks at G St at India St and/or G St at Columbia St. adjacent to Pantoja Park.

Thank you for your support on these issue and ensuring that we have safe streets throughout the city.
