Dear Councilman Ward,

I am writing on behalf of the Downtown Community Planning Council (DCPC). At our regular meeting on May 15, 2019 our board resolved to make the following request.

I am writing to you today to inform you of the results of a vote by the Downtown Community Planning Council. As you may recall, requests had been made to put stop signs at 15<sup>th</sup> & Island and 15<sup>th</sup> & J Street. The Downtown Community Planning Council voted on these requests last week and the results were unanimous with our board voting to support this request.

The neighborhood surrounding 15<sup>th</sup> & J and 15<sup>th</sup> & Island are growing at a rapid rate, making this a priority for the community. With an increase in residents and visitors, it is important to ensure safety within the neighborhood and create protected walkable areas for the community. These four-way stops will help ease traffic concerns and create a safe and secure neighborhood for residents and visitors alike.
